OLD BUSINESS / NEW BUSINESS

Rental of the facility and the liability to the club. There was a lot of discussion on this item. We only have 2 rentals per year. Members/Officers concerned about the liability insurance we have and that which we should require from a rental. Don Clark explained what we currently have. We do have a Directors & Officers policy. We have a one million dollar liability component. Still concern over how reduce the liability of the club. Don Clark will get costs for the renters to have the rider for \$1 million dollar event rider for the coverage of an event. A decision was made to table this decision on whether to halt all rentals or proceed with them this year until we have more info from Don Clark

on the insurance. A letter to the renting parties to be sent out. Our rental agreement form is very basic and may not qualify to protect the club.

NEW BUSINESS

Mike Morisette presented the club with the opportunity to have one of the activities from Running Water Recreation come to the club for the 100th Anniversary Bash. As well as possibly working with a local school to promote shooting and archery.

The club voted to accept his offer of the Archery Arena for an activity for those attending the celebration that would not be participating in the shooting event of the day.
