September 4, 2024 Meeting Detail

Meeting called to order by Gary Griswold

Secretaries report from August was read and accepted as read.

Treasurers report from August was read and accepted as read.

Old Business:

Fun 22 Shoot – Sunday September 8th, 2024.

The subject of handgun classes was again discussed. 2 programs that are locally done were presented as well as Women on Target thru the NRA and SubNoir the snub nose revolver group that Gary received info from.

Eric Larson spoke about what sts-nh.com (Mac Cashin, Eric Larson, Ryan Jarvis instructors) would offer to the club. We need to see the Tax Lawyer again to see how to do this the way that conforms to the IRS 501(c) 7 requirements.

New Business:

Info on Which Eye is your Dominant Eye was presented by Anthony Patti. Ann will email asking if any are interested in the product he mentioned.

Fun Matches - Presented by Bruce Simonds – he spoke about the matches that the club used to have. Volunteer to supply the targets for a fun match. Described the firearms and targets that would be used. It was suggested that he bring this back to a meeting in January, as there is not enough time nor manpower to make this happen for September 28th.

There was much discussion on getting something to interest younger members to participate, something for the youth in the area.

It was mentioned by Mark Lancaster that we attended the Haverhill Middle School community night again and had a lot of activity at our table for the Hunter Ed Program.

We had a full house for the 8/25 Hunter Ed field day – that was 16 people, six of them were under 15 and there were more females than males in the class.

We had a lot of discussion about the lack of participation by the younger members of the club. As well as an example of a program that works called Jake Day in Vt.

Chairs Missing from the clubhouse after the Rental – it was noted that about 24 chairs were missing after the Rental by the one group that rented this summer. So far we have not been able to reach the individual that handled the rental for that group. The cost of replacing the chairs would be between \$16 and \$28 each depending on that we purchase. (so more than what we brought in for monies from the rental)

Meeting Agenda and Notification of Important information – we were asked if the club can post or email the proposed agenda for each meeting for the members. So that they will be informed of the topics to be discussed and decisions that need to be made. We will attempt to do that prior to each meeting. Acquiring Adjustable Stools for the new shooting Benches Fun Matches – it was brought to the attention of the members present at the meeting that there have been complaints about people hitting their legs on the extensions at the shooting benches that hold the seat. It was noted that a number of shooters that come to the organized shoots do bring their own adjustable stools. It was thought by the member bringing it up that they could be purchased for around \$20 (research has found that they run from \$93 to \$140 each depending on style and weight they will hold) It was suggested that we could shorten up the extensions and possibly reduce the instances of leg banging.

We had one new member to vote in, Jesse Reed from Piermont NH. The motion was made to accept him he was Voted in. He was not at the meeting as he was working in Wyoming at the time.
